Cleaning & Aftercare Instructions for Your Stone Worktop:

Stone is a natural product and simple care and maintenance will keep it looking beautiful for many years. Here are some recommendations for routine care and cleaning.

It is always preferable to remove any spills immediately which might penetrate into the stone and cause stains and etching.

You can clean it regularly with a soft cloth and warm soapy water. Rinse the worktop again with fresh water. Finally you should dry the worktop to remove any remaining moisture. This will prevent any water spots or streaks.

We always recommend a neutral cleaner; don't use any aggressive detergents or vinegar.

You can also use a special stone cleaner, intended for natural stone or any commercially available cleaner which indicates that its use is safe on natural stone, marble and granite

Note: When first cleaning, some colour may leech from the worktop. This is natural. Since this could stain the materials used to clean we would recommend using an old cloth and towel.

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
