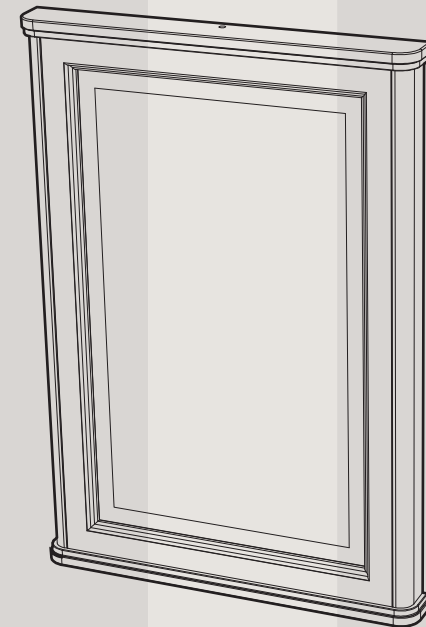

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

Ensure the mirror is securely mounted according to the enclosed instructions. Present the frame up to the mirror ensuring that the cut out for the Infra red sensor is on the bottom face

Secure the frame to the mirror through the top and bottom by fastening the self tapping screws provided with the mirror through the pre drilled holes and into the metal mirror frame

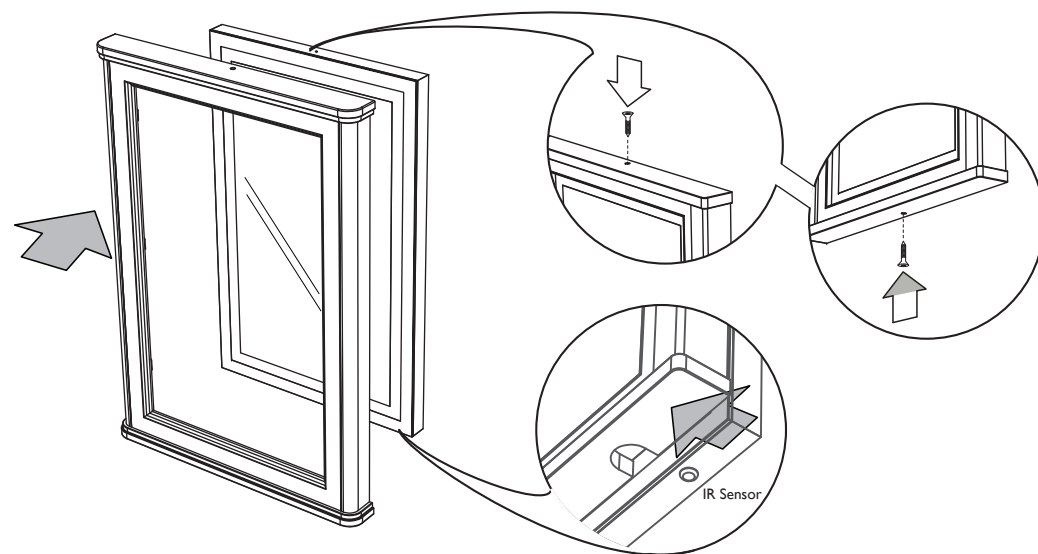
AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

Whilst the item has a high quality durable finish, it should nevertheless be treated with care. Surfaces should be cleaned only using a soft damp cloth and clean water and dried using a soft cotton cloth.

Bath cleaning products, even non scratch ones could damage the finished surface.

10YEAR GUARANTEE

We have complete confidence in this Laura Ashley product and as such it is offered with a 10-year guarantee against defects in manufacture. The guarantee requires that this product be used in the manner for which it was intended and that it is installed and maintained in accordance with the fitting instruction. The guarantee covers products in domestic use only. In the unlikely event that this product should fail during the guarantee period we will either replace the faulty part or the complete unit as appropriate. Light fittings and consumables are excluded from the guarantee but can be obtained by contacting customer services (see contact details overleaf).



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS Lighting is turned on / off using the Infra Red switch. The heated pad is on when the light is on. DO NOT leave on for prolonged periods of time..

ELECTRICAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS (Applicable to UK Installations only)

All fittings must be installed by a competent person, in accordance with current IEE wiring regulations. If in doubt consult a qualified electrician

IMPORTANT

Always switch off the electrical supply at the mains during installation and maintenance. It is recommended that the fuse is withdrawn or the circuit breaker is switched off for the necessary circuit before installation commences.

Fitting in Bathrooms is subject to the appropriate zone in accordance with IEE Regulations. This product is suitable for zone 2 and outside zones. IT IS NOT suitable for installation in Zone 0 or Zone 1. It is also not suitable for installation in saunas, steam rooms or shower cubicles. This product is only suitable for permanent installation. DO NOT connect to a trailing plug and socket outlet. Although this product has an Ingress Protection rating of IP44 it is only suitable for indoor use. Do not attach the product to surfaces that are damp or otherwise electrically conductive.

INSTALLATION CARE & SAFETY

Wear suitable eye protection when drilling. Take care when using power tools near water - the use of a residual current device (RCD) is advised. Beware of hidden cables or pipes. Take care if drilling on tiled surfaces in case the drill slips. A piece of masking tape applied to the wall before marking out the fixing holes will stop the drill from wandering.

DO NOT strike glass components with hard or pointed items. DO NOT place very hot or very cold items against or in close proximity to glass surfaces unless an adequately thick insulation material is used to prevent such items coming in contact with the glass. The nominal thickness of the mirror glass used in this product is 5mm and is film backed for safety. If the glass becomes chipped or broken replace immediately.

This product should be positioned well away from curtains and other fabrics. Never cover the mirror. This product is heated, we recommend that it is turned off after use and should never be left on for prolonged periods of time

This product could be dangerous and is only to be installed by a competent person.

CLEANING

It is recommended that the unit is cleaned with a soft, dry, non abrasive cloth when turned off. Never use cleaning agents or abrasive materials on any type of surface finish. Do not allow moisture to come into contact with the electrical components.

COMPLIANCE

This product complies with all relevant British and European safety standards:-

WIRING

This product must have an earth connection.

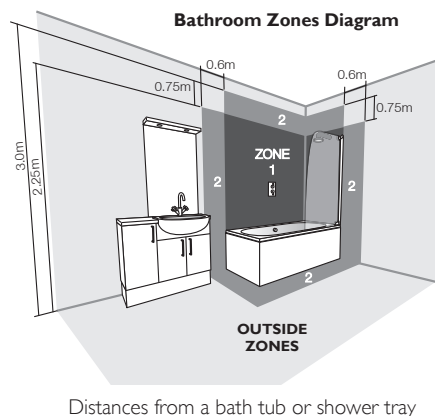

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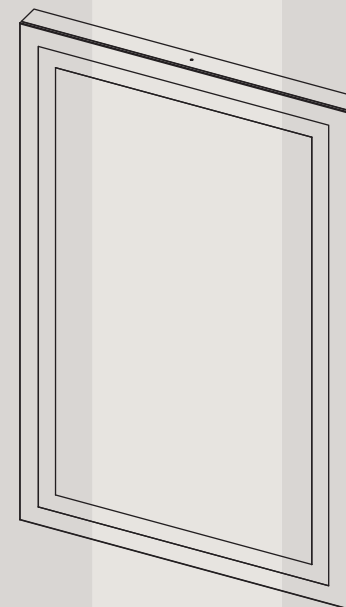

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

The wall surface must be of suitable strength and construction.

- 1) Measure the distance between the hole centres on the back of the mirror.
- 2) Draw a horizontal line on the wall at the desired height. Check with a spirit level.

Mark the drill positions on the horizontal line using dimension taken from step 1. Ensure the hole positions are horizontal by checking again with a spirit level.

- 3) Accurately mark the 2 hole positions with a pencil, drill and fit the wall plugs.

NOTE: The wall plugs supplied are only suitable for solid stone / brick walls. For plasterboard walls use specialist wall plugs.

- 4) The next step is to make the electrical connection from the mirror to the mains supply. Use the connection wire found at the rear of the mirror to make the necessary connections in accordance with the current IEE regulations. A second person will need to hold the mirror in place whilst electrical connections are made.

THIS PRODUCT MUST HAVE AN EARTH CONNECTION.

Colour Coding: L - Live = Brown N - Neutral = Blue ⊕ - Earth = Green & Yellow	Strip wires to a suitable length. DO NOT connect to a plug & socket outlet.

- 5) Insert the wall screws supplied into the wall plugs. Screw head should protrude approximately 5mm from hole (this may vary depending on individual installation). Mount the mirror onto the screws fitted to the wall. Ensure mirror is securely mounted.

- 6) Present the frame (supplied separately) up to the mirror ensuring that the cut out for the Infra Red sensor is on the bottom face.

- 7) Secure the frame to the mirror through the top and bottom by fastening the self tapping screws provided through the pre drilled holes and into the metal mirror frame.
